2. ADDING THE SITE MAP

2.1. Login to your respected AUTH website (e.g.: <u>https://auth-</u>

<u>agency.pa.egov.com/sites/dcnr/Pages/default.aspx</u>), go to the **page** you would like the site map to be on

- 2.1.2. Click Add a Webpart
- 2.1.3. Under PAI Enterprise, select "Custom Site Map"
